- 2) A typed statement (750 word maximum) that describes how your current interest in environmental dispute resolution warrants the CONCUR, Inc. Scholarship. Please include your academic and personal goals, as well as internship experience.
- 3) A printed list of your classes with grades, and all ENVS course narrative evaluations. You can retrieve this information from the Student Portal (<https://my.ucsc.edu>).
- 4) If you are a transfer student, you must include your transfer credit summary from the Student Portal (<https://my.ucsc.edu>). *You will need to use your log-in ID and your four-digit password/PIN. If you do not know your PIN, please contact the Registrar's Office at 9-4412, and press 3 to speak with a staff member.*
- 5) Your personal statement (item 2 from above) must also be submitted electronically to envs1@ucsc.edu as an attached Word document. Please send a separate email for each award to which you are applying with the name of the award in the subject line.
